MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)** signed at Srinagar on 1st day of July, 2021 is to strengthen the cooperation

BETWEEN

The National Centre for Good Governance (NCGG) has been set up by the Government of India (GoI) under the aegis of Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DAR&PG), Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, GoI by upgrading the National Institute of Administrative Research (NIAR), an autonomous Institution established under the aegis of Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA), Mussoorie India's apex training Institution for higher civil services. It aims to promote good governance through Capacity Building on Public Policy and Governance both at National and International level and carrying out studies/action research on issues relating to governance.

The Jammu & Kashmir Institute of Management, Public Administration and Rural Development (IMPARD), came into existence as an autonomous Society under the aegis of the State Government on 04.09.1986. The Institute was created for in-service training to the State Government employees as also to undertake research and consultancy in areas of crucial importance to the administration of the State. Recognizing the dire need for capacity building and skill enrichment among civil services, the Government planned to augment manpower pool so as to create high quality managerial cadre for manning different echelons of the administration. The basic premise of establishing the Institute was to inculcate quality decision making competencies among different individuals and organizations in the government.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED TO BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

It has been agreed between the Parties that they shall:

1. The objective of the MoU is to establish, maintain and enhance academic and intellectual interaction through specific initiatives detailed in this agreement with a view to promote excellence in Capacity Building

Programmes and practices relating to Good Governance, General Financial Rules (GFR) 2017, Public Private Partnerships (PPP) & e-Procurement with focus on GeM for the Training of 2000 Senior Officials including Jammu and Kashmir Administrative Service officers of the Government of Jammu and Kashmir for their mid career training programme on the same pattern of IAS training programme of DoPT Government of India.

2. The Institutions mentioned hereinafter referred to as Parties, in furtherance of their mutual interest in research and training and as contribution to increased bilateral cooperation between them, hereby agree within the framework of the regulations applying in each of the institutions and subject to the availability of resources.

Article 2: TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The terms and conditions, under which a specific programme/activity shall be undertaken under the terms of this memorandum, and any necessary financial arrangements to facilitate these will be the mutually discussed and agreed upon writing to all the parties prior to the intimation of the particular programme or activity.
2. Head or authorized representatives of the institutes (NCGG, DAR&PG and IMPARD) will be signing authorities for this agreement.
3. The Institutions may agree every year by letters on the contents of the activities to be taken up on an annual basis
4. The memorandum will enter into force from the date of its signing and will be valid for five years. After that if none of the parties has given notice for its termination or for its review, its validity will be renewed automatically for another term of five years. It may be terminated by either party giving a one year notice to the other party in writing. The termination of the Memorandum shall not affect any activity already in progress.

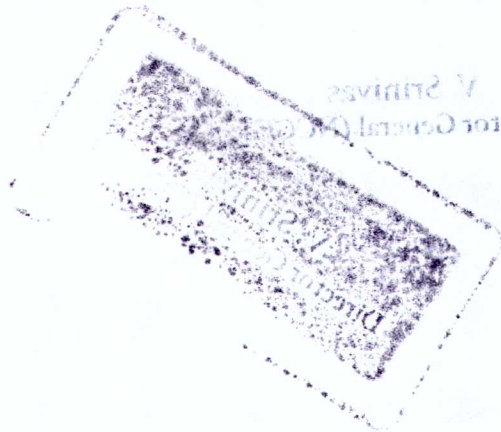
